## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S.W. Alder Street, Portland to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek , State of Oregon , has a right

for the purpose of

maintenance of pond for fish propagation and public fishing and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1882

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second to June 1 and 0.12 cubic foot per second thereafter; further limited to 1.25 acre foot per calendar menth to June 1 and 5.0 acre feet during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the SWM SEM, Section 29, T. 15 S., R. 33 E., W. M. Diversion point located 1110 feet North and 2010 feet West from the SE Corner\* A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate, together with certificate recorded at page 36593, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is issued to confirm a change in use, place of use, and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 14, 1961, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to E. J. Bayley and recorded at page 24876, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
