**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S.W. Alder Street, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of maintenance of pond for fish propagation and public fishing

under Permit No. 4310 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 18, 1919

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation and shall be further limited to 10 acre feet during the season April 1 to September 30 measured at point of diversion,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 15 S., R. 33 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 1110 feet North and 2010 feet West from SE Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate, together with certificate recorded at page 36592, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is issued to confirm a change in use, place of use, and point of diversion, approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 14, 1961, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. L. Braucht, and recorded at page 3752, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
