## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** C. C. ROBINSON

of R.F.D. No. 2, Box 455, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 42.6 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.86 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
30.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
both lying West of the Applegate River  
Section 6  
T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to C. C. Robinson and recorded at page 32909, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 48.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 0.7 acre was transferred and the point of diversion for the irrigation of 4.7 acres was changed by orders of the State Engineer entered June 15, 1965 and October 30, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to C. C. Robinson.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
