CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **NYE AND ALLENBY**

of 87 Whistler's Lane, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.6 acre

under Permit No. 24551 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 3, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 16, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1510 feet North and 1560 feet East from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 16, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 16
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in Point of Diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December 27, 1965, and together with Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 33017, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Nye and Allenby and recorded at page 28559, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
