## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That ED THOMPSON and C. W. WILCOX

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 33.8 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from March 1, 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.57 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

25.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
8.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 10  
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Ed Thompson and C. W. Wilcox and recorded  
at page 16116, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the  
right to the use of water for irrigation of 40.0 acres. Subsequently, the point  
of diversion for the irrigation of 6.2 acres was changed by order of the State  
Engineer entered November 10, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the  
remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate  
heretofore issued to Ed Thompson and C. W. Wilcox.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
