## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JOSEPHINE COUNTY - A Body Politic

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of McMullen Creek

a tributary of Deer Creek for the purpose of  
maintenance of Lake Selmac for recreation  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from August 22, 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per  
second during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.  
Diversion point located: 1325 feet North and 350 feet West from SE Corner, Section 13.  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the diversion point and use  
of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 25, 1966,  
and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to T. J. Breazeale  
and recorded at page 13837, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
