CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY C. CHRISTENSEN

of Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Deer Creek

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 30.91 acres

under Permit No. 2276 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 24, 1914

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.91 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
15.00 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Certificate of water right issued to Mary C. Christensen and recorded at page 4896, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 35.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 4.09 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered February 13, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Mary C. Christensen.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
