that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
(3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) 10 acros in the Southwest quarter of Southeast guarter of Section Twenty-three, Township Thirty-five South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Heridian, in Lake County, Oregon.
