Certificate of water right issued to G. W. Jorris and recorded at page 6403, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 31.5 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 4.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered October 31, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to G. W. Jorris.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
