CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That ANDREW F. and MAXINE F. LECKIE

of Fossil , State of Oregon , has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
John Day River
a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
irrigation of 86.2 acres
under Permit No. 32864 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from October 10, 1967

; ;
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
2.16 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 8 S., R. 25 E., W. M.
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 9 S., R. 25 E., W. M. Diversion
points located: 450 feet North and 2860 feet East; 1820 feet South and 4990 feet
East; 6250 feet South and 5190 feet East; all from NW Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
