CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALFRED FLICKINGER

of Route 1, Box 147, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-43074, Permit No. R-4904

a tributary of Soap Creek for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 32183 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within McClain DLC 47, Section 6, T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 2860 feet South and 1070 feet East from NW corner, Chamberlain DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
both as projected within McClain DLC 47
Section 6
T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
