CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE BUHLER

of Route 1, Box 252, Dallas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-39708, Permit No. R-4130 a tributary of Salt Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres and stock

under Permit No. 29769 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 6, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic foot per second, being 0.125 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, both as projected within J. Riggs DLC 75, Section 31, T. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4130,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Stock and 4.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within J. Riggs DLC 75
Section 31
T. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Dam - 250 feet South and 1840 feet West; Infiltration well - 250 feet South and 1790 feet West, both from NE Corner, James B. Riggs DLC 75.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
