CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FREEMAN LAND & LIVESTOCK CO.

of Route 1, Box 203, Rickreall, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Mud Slough for the purpose of domestic use in two houses and seven unit cabin and stock

under Permit No. 34040 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 12, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Spring located: 410 feet South and 760 feet West from E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and stock Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Domestic and stock NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
