**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **ARMOND J. ARNOLDUS**

of **Box 12, Alicel**      , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Grande Ronde River and Arnoldus Loop Reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-38317, Permit No. R-3412** a tributary of **Snake River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 191.5 acres**

under Permit No. **28920** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 12, 1962**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **3.0 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33; T. 1 S., R. 39 E., W. M.** Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-3412; provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than **300 c.f.s.** at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than **420 c.f.s.** at Oregon-Washington border,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

30.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
30.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.6 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$

27.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
28.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
38.3 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Diversion points located: **3630 feet West and 110 feet North; 1930 feet West and 80 feet North; 560 feet West and 1900 feet South; 30 feet West and 2010 feet South; all from the NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
