CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That E. S. McDONALD and J. B. ELDER (Partners)
of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake
for the purpose of the irrigation of 103 acres of land, domestic and stock use
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
(4.8 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 30 of each year) 4 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 37 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-five and 3 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty and 19 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-one, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen, all East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
