## Certificate of Water Right

of 1700 Cave Camp Road, Williams , State of Oregon , has a right<br>to the use of the waters of West Fork of Williams Creek<br>a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of<br>irrigation of 33.1 acres<br>and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April, 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the $\mathrm{NEXV}_{4} \mathrm{NW} / 4$, Section B, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 5340 feet West and 820 feet South from the $N / 4$ Corner, Section 9. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 29, 1964, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Joseph A. Boat and Henry Boat, and recorded at page 16319, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
