CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK G. HORVATH

of 6660 Reservoir Drive, Corvallis, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-38080, Permit No. R-3205 a tributary of Mary's River for the purpose of irrigation of 4.0 acres and recreation

under Permit No. 28556 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 17, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. for irrigation from unnamed stream and 0.01 c.f.s. for recreation from unnamed stream and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Newton DLC 42, Section 5, T. 12 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 270 feet South and 660 feet West from NE Corner, Newton DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Newton DLC 42
Recreation and 2.1 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Newton DLC 42
Section 5
T. 12 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
