CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLYDE L. WINSLOW and LORRAINE M. WINSLOW

of Route 1, Box 59A, Gold Beach, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring when available and deficiency in available supply from spring to be made up by appropriation from creek a tributary of Cedar Fork for the purpose of domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 31317 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 7, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T. 35 S., R. 14 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 2180 feet North and 1860 feet West; Spring located: 1430 feet North and 1590 feet West; both from SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
