CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. O. KOBBE

of **Oakland** , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and Umpqua River (Slough Channel)

a tributary of **Umpqua River** for the purpose of domestic use of one family and irrigation of 8.0 acres

under Permit No. **31149** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 20, 1965**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use and 0.10 c.f.s. from river for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21; Spring, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.0 acres Lot 8 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Domestic Lot 10 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 21
T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Spring - 770 feet North and 850 feet East; River - 1330 feet South and 1430 feet East; both from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 21.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
