CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL L. MERRILL

of 3135 East Hazelwood Street, Phoenix, State of Arizona, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Three springs

a tributary of Paradise Creek for the purpose of domestic use at a campsite

under Permit No. 33756 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$); Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 10, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M. Springs located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ (SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 10
T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Springs located: No. 1 - 2000 feet North and 90 feet East; No. 2 - 2040 feet North and 1190 feet East; No. 3 - 2180 feet North and 1300 feet East; all from SE Corner, Turner DLC 50.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
