CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ANNIE MOSS

of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake

for the purpose of the irrigation of 160 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of
1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth
below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(Proof No. 124 for the irrigation of 110 acres of land) 40 acres in the
Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-
three South, Range Eighteen: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest
quarter and 30 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section
Nineteen, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen: All East of Willamette
Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 125 for the irrigation of 50 acres of land) 2 acres in the South-
east quarter of Northeast quarter and 38 acres in the Northeast quarter of South-
east quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen:
10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Nineteen, Town-
ship Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen: All East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake
County, Oregon.

All of the above lands shall be limited to 4.8 acre feet per acre during
each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
