CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY Office of Business Affairs of Corvallis, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of four wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of fish research laboratory

under Permit No. G-2459 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 28, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.2 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Earl DLC 67, Section 36, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Wells located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Earl DLC 67 Section 36 T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Wells located: No. 1 - 220 feet North and 200 feet West; No. 2 - 300 feet North and 200 feet West; No. 3 - 290 feet North and 80 feet West; No. 4 - 420 feet North and 50 feet West; all from NW Corner, Robinette DLC 60.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
