## -CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to Certify, That** GEORGE S. PARK  
of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake  
for the purpose of the irrigation of 8.5 acres of land.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;  
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion  
of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth  
in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject to  
all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-  
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:  
(Proof No. 136 for the irrigation of 1 acre) Starting at the Town corner at  
the intersection of Main and Mill Streets; running West 480 feet to point of  
beginning; thence West 180 feet to Small Creek; thence southeasterly 230 feet  
along Small Creek; thence North 170 feet to point of beginning, in the Town of  
Paisley, Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 137 for the irrigation of 7.5 acres) 7.5 acres in the Northeast  
quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-three, Township Thirty-three South,  
Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

All of the above lands shall be limited to 3.9 acre feet per acre during  
each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
