confirmed dates from 1881

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September of each year,

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres SW/4 NE/4 15.0 acres SE/4 NE/4 Section 10 T. 8 S., R. 46 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to George Oliver and recorded at page 10425, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 85.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 45.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered April 17, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George Oliver.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
