**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** DEAN R. BOSS

of Box 537, Drain, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Novak Slough and Thomas Creek

a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation of 28.8 acres

under Permit No. 27973 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 9, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 9 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Lot 10 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 15, T. 10 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and provided further that water is to be diverted from Novak Slough when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Novak Slough is to be made up by diversion from Thomas Creek providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed 0.36 c.f.s.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.1 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	17.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

Diversion points located: Slough - 1130 feet North and 2020 feet West; Creek - 1130 feet North and 2920 feet West; both from the SE Corner, May DLC 64.

Certificate of water right issued to Dean R. Boss, Mabel D. Arnold Senz and/or Frank A. Senz and recorded at page 35358, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 50.4 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 21.6 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered March 27, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Dean R. Boss, Mabel D. Arnold Senz and/or Frank A. Senz.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
