CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MR. and MRS. FRANK M. MORRIS

of 6691 Green Road, Ottawa Lake, State of Michigan, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of Crooked Creek for the purpose of domestic use of one family, including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 29062 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 23, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¼ NE¼, Section 15, T. 13 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 3140 feet South and 1980 feet West from E¼ Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 15
T. 13 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
