CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **EARL and JEAN DAY**

P. O. Box 127
of **602 West Hemlock Avenue, Coos Bay**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **unnamed creek and Bald Mountain Creek**

a tributary of **Elk River** for the purpose of **domestic use of three families and fish culture**

under Permit No. **29894** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 4, 1964**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.26 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed creek for domestic and 0.25 c.f.s. from Bald Mountain Creek for fish culture**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 20, T. 33 S., R. 14 W., W. M.** Diversion points located: **2580 feet South and 1700 feet East; 4070 feet South and 1810 feet East; both from NE¹/₄ Corner, Section 20.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and fish culture **SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄**
Fish culture **SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄**
Section 20
T. 33 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
