CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHRISTINA SCHMIDT and WILLIAM SCHMIDT

of Lakeview, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Chewaucan River for the purpose of the irrigation of 115 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878 for 33 acres and 1898 for 82 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(Priority of 1878 for 33 acres) 17 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 11 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Thirty-six South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Priority of 1898 for 82 acres) 34.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 7 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 32.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Thirty-six South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

All of the above described lands shall be limited to 3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
