CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THE ESTATE OF JAMES G. DRISCOLL

of 13670 N.W. Laidlaw Road, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of nine unnamed springs and ponds constructed under Application No. R-33027, Permit No. R-2296 a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 26447 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 5, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, being 0.08 c.f.s. from Springs 1, 2, 4, and 5, 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring 3 and 0.04 c.f.s. from Springs 6, 7, 8, and 9

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 13 S., R. 27 E., W. M. Springs located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Springs located: No. 1 - 330 feet South and 1810 feet West; No. 2 - 460 feet South and 1810 feet West; No. 3 - 410 feet South and 1900 feet West; No. 4 - 520 feet South and 1910 feet West; No. 5 - 620 feet South and 1880 feet West; No. 6 - 740 feet South and 1510 feet West; No. 7 - 670 feet South and 1460 feet West; No. 8 - 430 feet South and 1490 feet West; No. 9 - 810 feet South and 1520 feet West; all from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 3.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
