## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

KENNETH MARSH

of 2045 Virginia Avenue, Baker , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Schaffner Creek

a tributary of Powder River (Snake River) for the purpose of irrigation of 1.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 13.4 acres

under Permit No. 30336 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 7, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW/A SW/A, Section 4, T. 10 S., R. 40 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 2480 feet South and 1080 feet East from NW Corner, SW/A NW/A, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured ander any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Primary Supplemental

5.6 acres SW4 NW4
1.6 acres 7.8 acres NW4 SW4

Section 4 T. 10 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
