a tributary of Powder River irrigation of 29.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33158 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Gregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 11, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.74 aubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NW/4 SW/4), Section 31, T. 10 S., R. 40 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 8150 feet South and 50 feet East from NW Corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reaconable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.1 acres SW/A NEWA
12.7 acres SEW/A NEWA
0.1 acre NEWA SEWA
3.6 acres NW/A SEWA

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
