for the purpose of

the irrigation of 1600 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject

to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: (Proof No. 159 for the irrigation of 135 acres) 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 25 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast cuarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Mineteen, Township Thirtythree South, Range Ninoteen East of Willacette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 160 for the irrigation of 25 acres) 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 15 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

All of the above described lands shall be limited to 4.6 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
