CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ROBERT K. and ELIZABETH C. HASTINGS**

of Box 111, Harbor, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cooley Creek, Hastings Creek and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-44201, Permit No. R-5021, a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 36.0 acres

under Permit No. 32659 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 7, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic foot per second, being 0.20 c.f.s. from Cooley Creek and 0.16 c.f.s. from Hastings Creek and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$); Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 22, T. 41 S., R. 13 W., W. M. Diversion points located: 860 feet South and 2750 feet West; 1440 feet South and 1680 feet West; both from NE Corner, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5021,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
26.0 acres Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 22
T. 41 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
