CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THOMAS K. WALWORTH

of P. O. Box 598, Florence, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Woahink Lake

a tributary of Siltcoos River for the purpose of domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 33377 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 13, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NW¼ SE¼), Section 14, T. 19 S., R. 12 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 16.4 feet North and 45.1 feet East from NW Corner, Lot 11, Block 1, Woahink Acres.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 7 (NW¼ SE¼)  
Section 14  
T. 19 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows:  
Lot 11, Block 1 Woahink Acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
