**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      JAMES MCEWEN

of **Riverside**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **South Fork Malheur River**

a tributary of **Snake River** for the purpose of irrigation of **58.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 13.4 acres**

under Permit No. **27921** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **November 16, 1961**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.8 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 30, T. 24 S., R. 37 E., W. M.** Diversion point located: **5600 feet North and 4460 feet West from the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Corner, Section 32.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is issued subject to the terms and conditions of an order of the State Engineer dated **March 29, 1962** and recorded at **Volume 11, pages 512 to 523, Special Order Record**, and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
