CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ORIN L. and DELLA MAY WELLS, et. al.

of 4735 Highway 66, Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Neil Creek

irrigation of 34.9 acres and domestic use
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1854

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per
second

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
