CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **KATHLEEN N. RUDELL and**
THE ESTATE OF DELBERT C. RUDELL

of Route 1, Box 2115, Coquille, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Through Creek

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.0 acres, supplemental irrigation of 5.3 acres, harvesting and temperature control of 7.3 acres under Permit No. 31788 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second, being 0.18 c.f.s. for irrigation and supplemental irrigation, 0.20 c.f.s. for harvesting and 0.20 c.f.s. for temperature control

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¼ SW¼, Section 3, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 570 feet South and 2530 feet East from NW Corner, NE¼ SE¼, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, water diverted for temperature control during the irrigation season to be so far as is possible part of that authorized for irrigation; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
