**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      JAMES M. PITMAN

of Galice Road, Merlin, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-fourth acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 30486 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW¼ SW¼), Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 437.9 feet South and 25 feet East from the W¼ Corner of Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (NW¼ SW¼)  
Section 11  
T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows:

A tract of land located in Lot 1, Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Southerly right of way line of the relocated Merlin Galice County Road which is South 01° 03' West of and 85.9 feet distance from the West quarter corner of Section 11; thence South 76° 26' East along said right of way line for 249.0 feet; thence South 01° 03' West for 359 feet, more or less, to mean high water mark of Rogue River; thence Westerly to a point which bears South 01° 03' West to the point of beginning; thence North 01° 03' East for 352 feet to the point of beginning. Less and Except a 20 foot wide public road recorded in Volume 199, Page 246, Josephine County Deed Records.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
