CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HUGO NOTHEISEN

of 2484 Rogue River Highway, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 1.34 acres

under Permit No. 32238 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 27, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.017 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21, T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 2440 feet North and 765 feet West from SE Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.34 acres Lot 8 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 21
T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows:
Lots 13, 14, 15, 16 of Del Rogue Tracts.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
