This right is subject to the terms that the use of water for cooling in excess of 5,000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system is recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
