CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **PORTLAND RENDERING COMPANY**
Division of Darling-Delaware Company, Inc.
of P. O. Box 17201, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
a well

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of
cooling of condensers

under Permit No. **G-3869** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **April 16, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
2.22 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within Windle DLC, Section
5, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W. M. Well located: South 52° 49' 48", West 677.35 feet
from NE Corner, J. Windle DLC.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within Windle DLC
Section 5
T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W. M.

This right is subject to the terms that the use of water for cooling in excess of
5,000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consum-
ptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the
system is recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
