**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That M. R. LONG**

of Route 2, Box 5, Days Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Days Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 28.0 acres

under Permit No. 32718 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 6, 1967 for 0.06 c.f.s. October 19, 1967 for 0.29 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , both as projected within Thomas DLC 48, Section 10, T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
19.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
2.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
all as projected within Thomas DLC 48  
Section 10  
T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: 400 feet North and 870 feet West; 840 feet North and 100 feet West; both from SW Corner, Worley DLC 49.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
