CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOHN MASSON AND JOHN DAMON  
of Mount Vernon, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation  
under Permit No. 3751 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the  
STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of  
said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 447, on the 15th day of November, 1922;  
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 4, 1918

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.75 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irriga-  
tion shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is  
appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is  
as follows: 17 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 17 acres  
in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four and 26 acres  
in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township  
Thirteen South, Range Twenty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Grant County,  
Oregon. Containing in all 60 acres of land.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from  
the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under  
the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby con-  
firmed and limited.
