CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 4

of 1058 West Harvard Street, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.5 acres

under Permit No. 27660 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 6, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Hardy DLC 59, Section 5, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1140 feet North and 480 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow in the South Umpqua River is more than 60 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Hardy DLC 59
Section 5

3.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Hardy DLC 59
Section 8
T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
