**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That      JOHN R. McARTHUR**

of Box 266, Cheshire      , State of Oregon      , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Tom River and Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625

a tributary of      Willamette River      for the purpose of irrigation of 19.0 acres

under Permit No. 33764      of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 17, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Taylor DLC 55, Section 10, T. 16 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Reservoir-NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-6369 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the State Engineer;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.7 acres Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
11.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Taylor DLC 55  
Section 10  
T. 16 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

River diversion point located 30 feet North and 2570 feet West from E $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 10.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
