## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLSON C. and MAXINE E. RICH

of Route 2, Box 483, Lebanon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of unnamed stream irrication of 13.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-3469 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that he priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW SWM, as projected within Hardman DLC 54, Section 20, T. 11 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Well located: 230 feet South and 1490 feet East from SW Corner, Burkhardt DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.6 acres NEW SWW.
1.8 acres NWW SWW.
0.3 acre SWW SWW.
5.8 acres SEW SWW.
all as projected within Hardman DLC 54
Section 20
T. 11 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
