CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THEODORE N. BOKIDES

of Route 4, Weiser, State of Idaho, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 327.9 acres under Permit No. 31319 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 7, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.90 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄), Section 21, T. 15 S., R. 46 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 1100 feet South and 4580 feet East from NW Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

an unnamed stream and Drift Creek, tributary of Pudding River appropriated under
Application No. 38021, Permit No. 28164 in two unnamed reservoirs

for the purposes of
irrigation
under Reservoir Permit No. R-2992 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed dates from August 31, 1962

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed 13.0 acre feet, being 7.0 a.f. in South Reservoir and 6.0 a.f.
in North Reservoir
