CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LEONARD PETERS

of Route 2, Box 13 A, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed drainage ditch and Luckiamute River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 171.0 acres

under Permit No. 31440 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 18, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.14 cubic feet per second from unnamed drainage ditch when available and any deficiency in the available supply from the drainage ditch may be made up by appropriation from Luckiamute River provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 2.14 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 9 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: Ditch - 1150 feet South and 2,710 feet West; 1570 feet South and 900 feet West; River - 4810 feet South and 1070 feet West; 4840 feet South and 640 feet West; all from the SE Corner, Elkins DLC 44.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
