CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. R. INKS

of **Bandon**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-33040, Permit No. R-2238

a tributary of **Coquille River** for the purpose of irrigation of **3.0 acres of cranberries**

under Permit No. **26134** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 20, 1959**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.0384 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 20, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M. Diversion point located: **980 feet South and 1700 feet East from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 20.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-tenth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **0.75 acre foot per acre** for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **6 acre feet per year** during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-2238. If for irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited *(see below) and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**3.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17
T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M.**

*to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-2238.

Certificate of water right issued to H. R. Inks and R. M. Henry and recorded at page 33048, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of **6.25 acres**. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to **3.25 acres** was approved by order of the State Engineer entered December 22, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to H. R. Inks and R. M. Henry.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
