CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD L. and RUTH G. CRAIN

of 1609 Jackson Road, Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 12.0 acres and domestic use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1860;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second.
